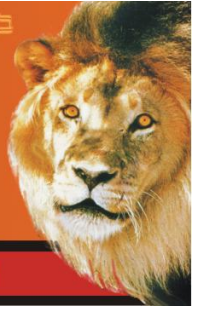

At lunchtime, travel to Kings Camp, Timbavati Private Game Reserve, part of the greater Kruger Park that combines the advantages of off-road game-viewing and tracking with the huge animal population of the Kruger Park. Enjoy a late afternoon safari in the Park.

Visit the Penguin colony and, weather-permitting, take a boat cruise out to Seal Island. If time, enjoy a spectacular hike round the Cape of Good Hope. Take the late flight back to Johannesburg.

Catch an early flight to Livingstone, Zambia, gateway to the mighty Victoria Falls. View the mighty Vic Falls from the Zambian side and experience the magnificence of one of the seven wonders of the world.

**Tuesday,
July 17**

Vic Falls / Chobe



Take a leisurely, early-morning elephant-back stroll through the veld. Then cross over to Zimbabwe and view the magnificent and massive Falls late morning. After lunch, cross the Zambezi River into Botswana and enjoy an afternoon boat cruise safari along the Chobe River looking for hippo, crocodile, and perhaps even the rare sight of elephants crossing the river. Enjoy an early morning boat cruise safari along the Chobe River and, after lunch, enter the Chobe National Park by jeep, and catch some of Chobe's elephant herds, Impala, Kudu and other animal species.

Take a final early morning jeep safari and then transfer back to Livingstone airport and fly back to Johannesburg, OR Tambo airport in time for your international flight back home.
