**Sunday June  
24**

### Dar es Salaam



Take an evening flight (21:00) from Johannesburg to Dar es Salaam, Tanzania. On arrival (+- 1:30 am), clear customs and drive to an overnight hotel by the sea for a few hours rest.

**Monday June  
25**

### Arusha/Kilimanjaro



After a late breakfast overlooking the ocean, Take a mid-afternoon flight to the Northern Tanzanian town of Arusha, gateway to the Serengeti area. On landing, hope for clear enough weather to view Africa's highest peak, the 5800m high Mount Kilimanjaro, and a chance for some great photos. Drive through the great African Rift Valley, past Lake Manyara, to Ngorongoro farmshouse, where we spend the night.

**Tuesday  
June 26**

### **Ngorongoro**



Drive into the Ngorongoro Conservation area, driving up the escarpment into the Ngorongoro highlands and descending rapidly into the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater, home to one of the densest concentrations of wildlife in the world. Spend the morning and early afternoon searching for the many animals that make this unbroken caldera their home.

**Wednesday  
June 27**

### **Serengeti**



Travel through the Ngorongoro conservation area to Naapi Hill Gate, where we enter the world's greatest Game Reserve- The endless plains of the Serengeti. Here, the search for Serengeti's many animal species begins, hoping to find some of the massive herds of Wildebeest that migrate annually throughout the park-known to many as the "greatest wildlife show on Earth."

**Thursday  
June 28**

### **Serengeti**



Enjoy a full day on safari in the Serengeti, looking out for lion, cheetah, elephant, buffalo, hyena, giraffe, zebra, gazelles, migrating herds of wildebeest, and many more indigenous species of wildlife,

**Friday June 29**

### **Serengeti**



The Serengeti's about the world's greatest safari , and we spend another magical full day amongst the endless open plains, with some of the best game-viewing visibility in the world. Return to lodge on time to prepare for Shabbos.

30**

### **Serengeti**



Enjoy a unique Shabbos at a lodge inside the Serengeti National Park, where you have the chance of spotting animals from your balcony, the lounge, or the outdoor areas of the hotel.

July 1**

### **Serengeti/Lake Victoria**



Drive through Serengeti's Western corridor, hoping for some more migration sightings and other animals. Exit the Park on the Lake Victoria Side, with a chance to view the massive inland sea that makes up the world's second largest lake. Travel to the lakeside city of Mwanza, and fly to Dar es Salaam, Tanzania's bustling seaside capital. Relax in a hotel lobby and take a late-night/early morning flight back to Johannesburg.
